



Trumbull Nature and Arts Center Prepares to Go FULL CIRCLE with Sustainable Playground Town Prepares for Opening Dedication Scheduled for October 23rd

(Trumbull, CT, October 7, 2009): The Trumbull Nature and Arts Center is set to go full circle on October 23rd as the site for a sustainable playground donated to the Town of Trumbull (CT) by The Sun Products Corporation, a Wilton-based fabric care and household products company. The Trumbull Nature and Arts Center has also teamed up with Bullard Haven Technical School in Bridgeport (CT) to assist in renovations while giving students hands-on construction experience. Under the guidance of licensed instructors, Bullard Haven students will be reducing the carbon footprint of the Trumbull Nature and Arts Center and keeping the environmental impact of the Center to a minimum. The materials for this portion of the construction were made possible by a grant from the Mallett Trust Foundation.
